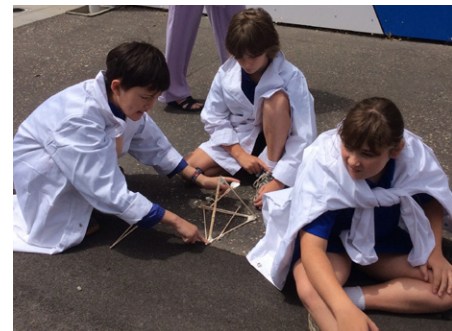
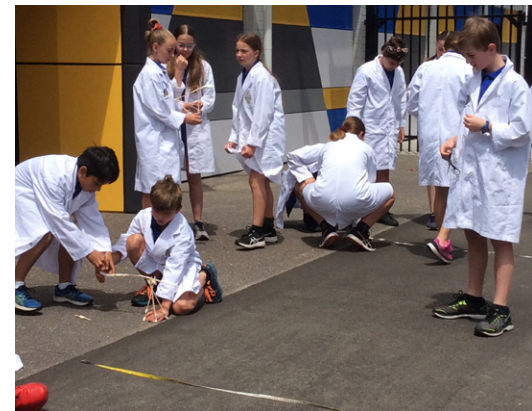

FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S DESK



As we come to the end of the 2020 school year I would like to thank everyone for the support and hard work by so many that enabled us to navigate a particularly tricky year.

Whilst we have had to make some changes to ensure the health and well-being of our community we have been able to achieve this and minimise disruption to our students.

I would like to make special mention of the staff at Adam Road PS who have never lost focus on providing the very best possible for our students. Equally our students have acquitted themselves really well and engaged positively in school programs. I regularly get great feedback regarding the performance and behaviour of our students from visitors to our school and community members who have seen our students representing Adam Road.

Our Final Assembly on Friday 11 December and Year 6 Graduation on Wednesday 16 December are great ways to acknowledge the achievements of many of our students throughout this year. So that we can meet current requirements for public gatherings we are inviting parents/carers of award winners (maximum of 2 per student) to attend the Final Assembly. We are able to increase this to a maximum of 4 family members/carers per student for the Year 6 Graduation. Please adhere to these numbers and follow the latest social distancing requirements set by the government.

We are making some changes to the structure of the school day in 2021. School start and finish times will not change. Our school day will be comprised of five sixty minute sessions as opposed to the six fifty minute sessions we have had this year.
