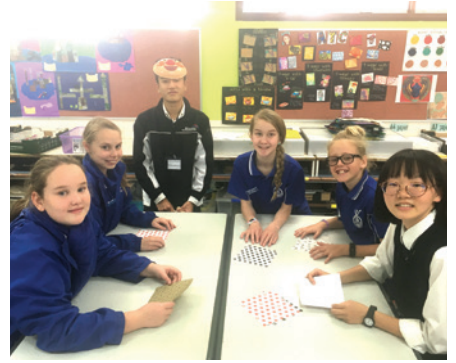




# JAPANESE EXCHANGE STUDENTS
