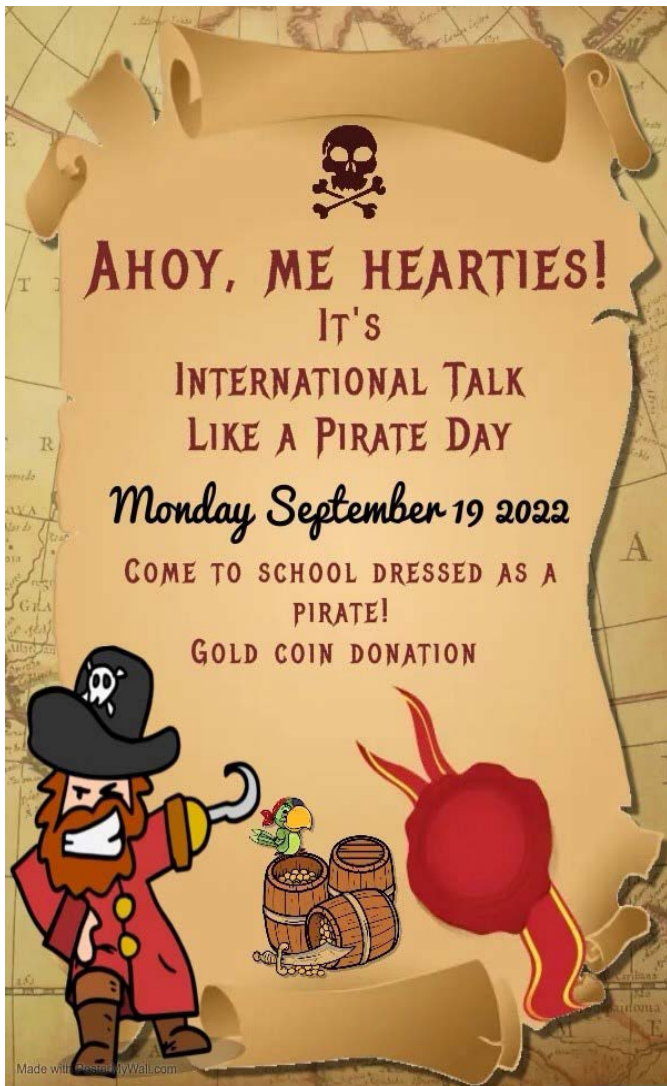
FAMILY PICNIC
