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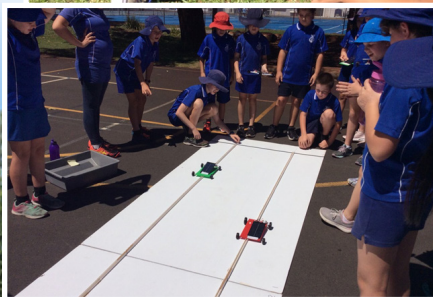

SCIENCE NEWS

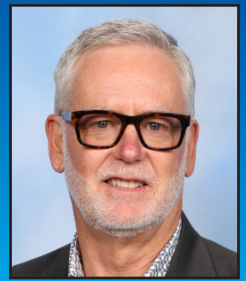
It has been an exciting start to the year in Science as all classes make progress in the physical sciences area of the curriculum.

- In Year 1, we have been getting familiar with the new Science lab and exploring the world of sound and light.
- Year 2 has been learning about push and pull forces to design and produce a Rube Goldberg machine.
- In Year 3, students have been exploring heat by using infrared thermometers to record temperature changes in objects exposed to differing heat sources.
- Year 4 has been investigating forces such as pushes, pulls, friction and gravity by conducting various experiments.
- In Year 5, we have been examining how light works by drawing ray diagrams and using mirrors and magnifying glasses to reflect and bend light.
- Year 6 has been learning about electrical circuits by assembling small circuits and constructing solar cars in preparation for the Synergy Solar Car Challenge.
