Please note school assemblies now begin at 2:15pm on scheduled Fridays.

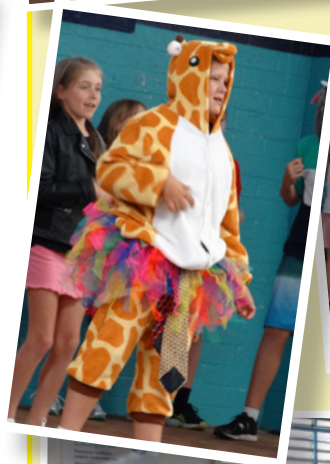
