



## National Simultaneous Storytime



Rooms 1, 2 and 3 joined over 1,297,825 participants, from over 14,469 locations in the biggest National Simultaneous Storytime ever, reading Whitney and Britney Chicken Divas, written and illustrated by Lucinda Gifford.

National Simultaneous Storytime (NSS) is held annually by the Australian Library and Information Association (ALIA). Every year a picture book, written and illustrated by an Australian author and illustrator, is read simultaneously in libraries, schools, preschools, childcare centres, family homes, bookshops and many other places around the country. Now in its 20th successful year, it is a colourful, vibrant, fun event that aims to promote the value of reading and literacy, using an Australian children's book that explores age-appropriate themes, and addresses key learning areas of the National Curriculum for Foundation to Year 6.

It is pleasing to report that once again in all areas tested by NAPLAN in 2019, Numeracy, Reading, Grammar and Punctuation, Writing and Spelling both our Year 3 and Year 5 students have out-performed students in like schools. Also included in the report is information on enrolments and school attendance. We have seen an increase in enrolments in 2020 but we need to improve our attendance figures.
