## PBS UPDATE FOR OUR PARENT COMMUNITY

### WE NEED YOUR SUPPORT, INVOLVEMENT AND CREATIVE IDEAS!

Adam Road Primary School is in the process of implementing a school-wide approach to behaviour management called Positive Behaviour Support (PBS).

This is a strategy for helping all students achieve important social and learning goals. As part of the PBS framework we have established clear behaviour expectations for everyone in our school community. These are based on our existing values of:

### ENDEAVOUR RESPONSIBILITY RESPECT RESILIENCE TOLERANCE

Behaviour expectations relating to each value are now visible in classrooms, transition and play areas of the school, displayed on our "Values and Behaviours" charts. Stating and displaying these positive behaviours gives a reference point for all school community members and promotes common language and understanding.

We are streamlining the way we explicitly teach these behaviours to all students and how we continue to acknowledge positive behaviour. These behaviour expectations will build on our social/emotional and academic learning programme.

We are asking the school community to help us by creating mascots that represent our positive behaviour expectations and our school culture. We want to incorporate our traditional and well-loved theme of "Adam Roadsters on the Highway to Success". Entrants are encouraged to create vehicle mascots that represent our values and inspire our community, especially our students. Specific guidelines and criteria are on a separate sheet which has been sent home to each family.

Displaying and promoting our values and positive behaviour expectations will make our school's message more accessible and effective. We believe that by helping students understand and practise positive behaviours, we will more effectively build a school community where all students can grow and succeed.

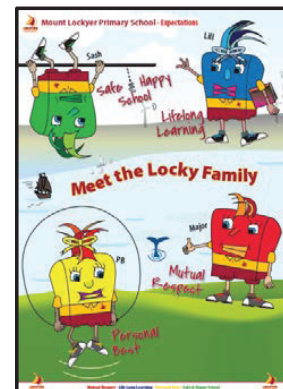
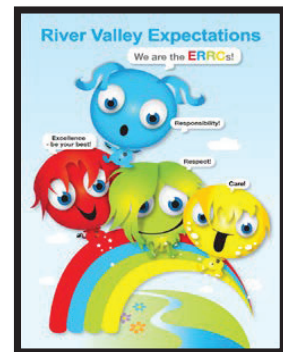
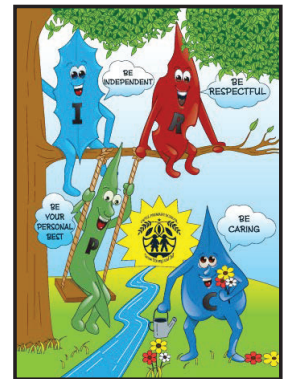
- Mascots must be on A4 or A3 paper with an entry form attached.

## CRITERIA (WHAT YOUR DESIGNS MUST HAVE)

- Our five school values will be represented by five **vehicle** mascots. The five final vehicle designs will be placed on the “Highway to Success”.
- You can design 1, 2,3,4 or all 5 of the vehicle mascots.
- Each vehicle you design, with its character and action, should represent a school value and the positive behaviours we want to achieve. Check the school “Values and Behaviours” chart in your classroom for some ideas of the behaviours that demonstrate each Value.
- Each vehicle should be the colour of its Value. These are:

<b>Endeavour:</b>	purple
<b>Responsibility:</b>	orange
<b>Respect:</b>	lime green
<b>Resilience:</b>	bright pink
<b>Tolerance:</b>	bright turquoise blue

- Drawing tips –
  - use bold lines
  - keep it simple – not too many small details
  - give your vehicles emotion and animation
  - make your vehicles individual – different from each other.
- Text – make it stand out– use bold text
